Three hens laid 19 eggs in total.


Each hen laid an odd number of eggs. How many eggs did each hen lay?

Write the alphabet out on a piece of paper. Tear into individual letters. Set out two hoops or buckets (or something similar) and place the consonants into one and the vowels into the other.

Each time you throw the ball into one of the hoops pick either a consonant or a vowel, depending on which hoop the ball landed in. Once you have had a few turns try to use the letters you have to make a word. What is the longest word you can make?
