I am sure that you are all aware of the impending changes to Covid guidance but I thought it would be useful to capture these here:

Covid Update

From May 1st there are further significant changes to the Public Health Advice for those experiencing symptoms of Covid.

From April 30th test sites will close and people with symptoms are no longer advised to take a PCR test.

The public health advice is for people who feel unwell to stay at home. There is no designated isolation period any longer. This applies to our pupils as well as adults of course.

This is really positive. The data linked to the virus is much more encouraging and these are significant steps forward. I hope that these new rules provide optimism and hope for brighter times.

Holiday Reminder

Please do be aware that school is open on Monday 2nd May 2022. Although initially a holiday, this date has been moved to June to provide a long weekend to celebrate the jubilee. We are very much open tomorrow (Monday)!

<u>SNSA</u>

All school children in P1, P4, P7 and S3 complete online standardised assessments in literacy and numeracy. These assessments help us to identify progress and provide us with information that help us to support our children's learning moving forward. These assessments are underway and delivered digitally, using the school's ipads. They are adaptive which means that if a child is experiencing difficulties, the questions will get easier but if a child is doing well, the questions become more challenging. This is a method used to establish the children's capacity without them having to face lots of questions which are too easy or too hard for them to answer.









We use these assessments to plan the appropriate next steps and support. This helps us to provide the right support at the right time for all our learners. There is no 'pass or fail' these simply give insights into learning, progress and next steps.
