Below is a grid of learning activities for Second level (P5, P6 and P7).

<p>Maths- Using the 4 operations. How many different answers can you make using the numbers below:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">5 9 2 6</p>	<p>Literacy- Comic Book Using an app or with paper, create your own comic book. Remember: Include speech bubbles and story sequence words or short sentences.</p>	<p>HWB- Strongest bridge Using paper or newspaper, build a bridge. Choose an object you have lots of. See how many your bridge can hold. Now, try to improve your bridge so it can hold more.</p>
<p>Maths- Multiplication fact Choose a multiplication fact. Write it in the centre of your paper. Around it, write or draw as many different ways you can show that fact. Do it for 2 more.</p>	<p>Literacy- Word challenge Using the letters below, how many words can you make:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">L A U R E N C E K I R K S C H O O L</p>	<p>HWB- Family connections Choose 8 categories (e.g. animals, food, you tuber) and write down your favourite for each. Now chat with each member of your family and write down their favourite for each. Are they the same? Different?</p>
<p>Maths- Valto's cards are all different. There is a number from 1 -8 on each card. He has chosen four cards that add up to 20. What are they? There are 7 possibilities.</p>	<p>Literacy- Choose a fairy tale (goldilocks and the three bears, the three little pigs etc). Change the characters and rewrite the story. How would it be different?</p>	<p>HWB- Being Healthy Design an active game you could play by yourself or with friends or family. Make sure you test it out. Do you need to make any changes?</p>
<p>Maths- Colouring pencils This colour pencil track has 4 squares. If the pattern of squares is continued, how many pencils will be needed to build a track of 60 squares?</p>  <p>How many to build a track of 82 squares?</p>	<p>Literacy- Choose a book and read for enjoyment. Would this be a book you would recommend to your friends?</p>	<p>HWB- Kindness and Friendship Younger children are learning how to be kind and how to be a good friend. Think about acts of kindness you can do and what you can do to be a good friend. Make a guide for younger children. Remember to include pictures and simple language.</p>
